What is needed for a Child Care Provider to participate in the CACFP?

- A clear DHS Certificate of Registration
- Serve meals according to Meal Pattern Requirements for Older Children (1-12 years) and Infants (0-11 months)
- Keep accurate attendance & menu records on DAILY BASIS
- Be available for no less than 3 monitoring visits per year from a CACFP monitoring staff member
- Participate in and complete the mandatory annual nutrition training
